For the first time EVER we have included ACTIVITES for games or crafts. These are designed for mixed ages or children's groups. All carry the essential idea of linking into the story and nature. These have been added to complement the wondering and wandering and not in place of them. People have asked for something for the summer that is easy to use, free (or VERY low cost) but offers fun in the gathering together.

Each story comes with:

- A copy of the passage
- A wandering page
- 4 wondering stops
- Activity page

¹⁴ Jesus... saw a large crowd, he had compassion on them and healed their sick.

¹⁵ As evening approached, the disciples came to him and said, "This is a remote place, and it's already getting late.





Send the crowds away, so they can go to the villages and buy themselves some food."





²⁰ They all ate and were satisfied, and the disciples picked up twelve basketfuls of broken pieces that were left over.



²¹ The number of those who ate was about five thousand men, besides women and children.









Here is an image that you might like to colour and to think about the story.


Sometimes it is helpful to stop and slow down. I wonder what colours you will choose?













Early in the morning, Jesus stood on the shore, but the disciples did not realize that it was Jesus. ⁵ He called out to them, "Friends, haven't you any fish?" "No," they answered.

⁶ He said, "Throw your net on the right side of the boat and you will find some." When they did, they were unable to haul the net in because of the large number of fish.





⁷Then the disciple whom Jesus loved said to Peter, "It is the Lord!" As soon as Simon Peter heard him say, "It is the Lord," he wrapped his outer garment

around him (for he had taken it off) and jumped into the water.

⁸ The other disciples followed in the boat, towing the net full of fish, for they were not far from shore, about a hundred yards.





When they landed, they saw a fire of burning coals there with fish on it, and some bread. ¹⁰ Jesus said to them, "Bring some of the fish you have just caught."

¹¹ So Simon Peter climbed back into the boat and dragged the net ashore. It was full of large fish, 153, but even with so many the net was not torn.

¹² Jesus said to them, "Come and have breakfast." None of the disciples dared ask him, "Who are you?" They knew it was the Lord. ¹³ Jesus came, took the bread and gave it to them, and did the same with the fish.







Counting Petals



If you can find a flower with lots of petals (like a daisy or dandelion) get people to look at the flower and guess how many petals.

Be open to asking if they noticed anything else as they were looking at the flower.

If you are near some trees you could do it to guess how many leaves.... It doesn't matter that no-one knows!

Make some flat bread to cook over a campfire (taking care!) Flour, oil, water... mix together, make into a ball and squash it!



Make a Nature Mandala


Find 4 large sticks or mark out a frame. Invite people to gather items and together to make a picture or pattern within the frame.

JUMP IN, JUMP OUT


Have an invisible line or something to represent a river (or the lake!)

- Jump over







One person (chosen) says "Grumble, grumble, grumble", trying to keep their identity secret.


The person in the middle has to guess who is grumbling!






One person is the leader and when they 'tag' someone else they have to join together to make a chain until everyone is included!








Create a leaf garland - everyone can join in adding their leaves!

(A hole punch, string and leaves is all you need)




