A fresh wander through the Advent story





Welcome to the ADVENTURE, this is a trail designed to be used outdoors, to help you connect with your community, nature and God. We invite you to wander through the Christmas story, to take time, space and explore the journey afresh.

These resources have been designed as a trail but each character can be considered individually at your own pace. It offers opportunities for groups, individuals or families to wander and can be set up around an outdoor space – this could be a park, garden or on your local lampposts. The resource pack also has pages to reflect further on the character or story. Each story comes blank – you add the colour, faces, expression either drawing or in your mind. This could also offer an opportunity for households to take a character and decorate it and then display it as part of the trail, or different groups within a church or classes in a school to create their own character as part of the trail.

Each section offers

- a Wander sheet with questions or reflections for an outdoor space
- A Wonder sheet with questions to wonder about (this could be done outdoors or afterwards or inside)
- An Activity sheet that links to the story and offers extra activities to build on the character and wondering. This is more aimed at children but most things can be done by all ages!
