Spring flowering bulbs need a cold winter to sleep through. Then each bulb is a complete package and if you cut some open you could even find the baby flower squeezed inside.

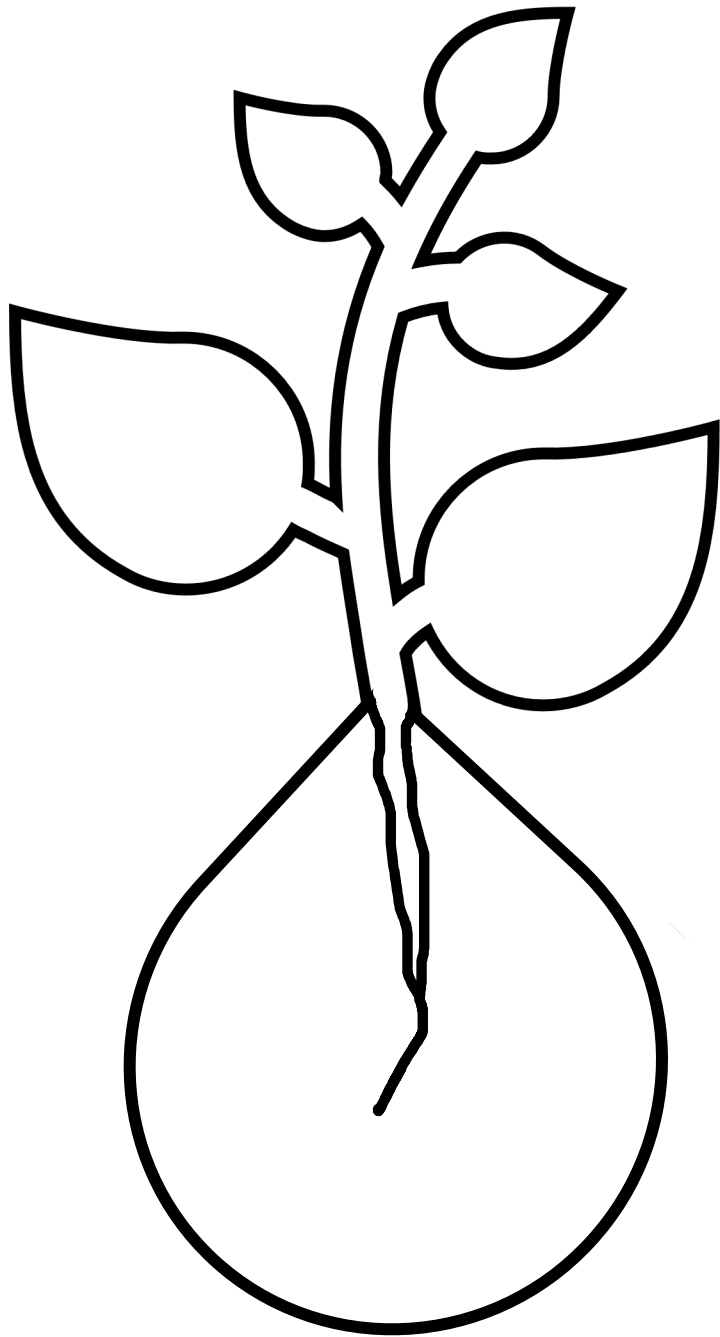
