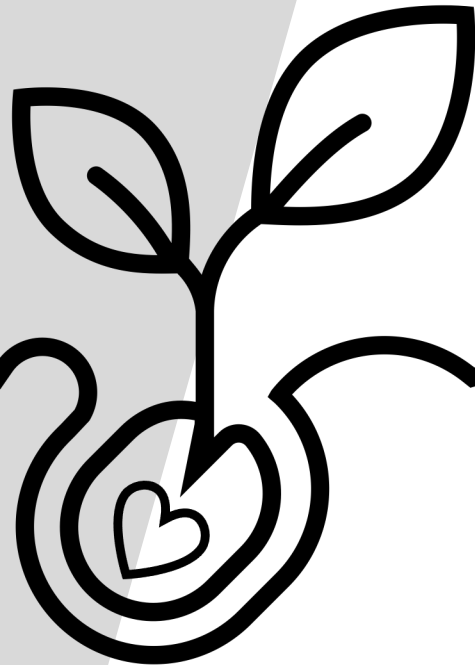









Can you see something that has persevered?
