Make a mountain with some goals you would like to achieve over the next week or month



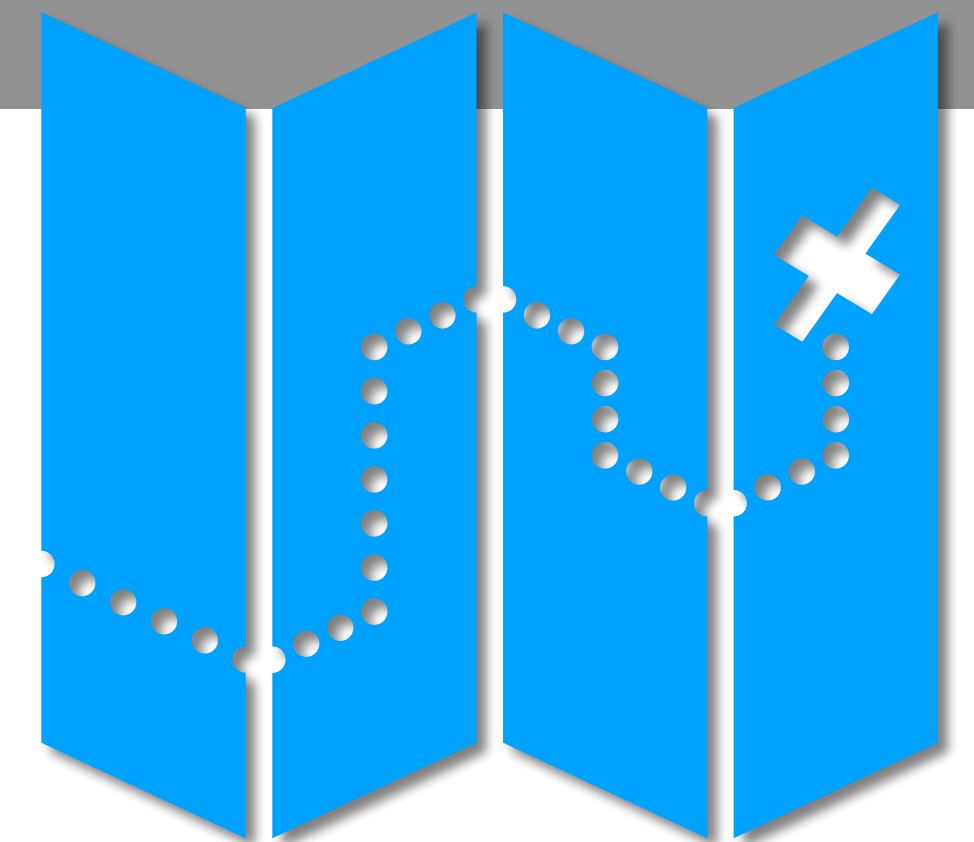
**Make a Lockdown Newspaper....

They shall walk and not faint.

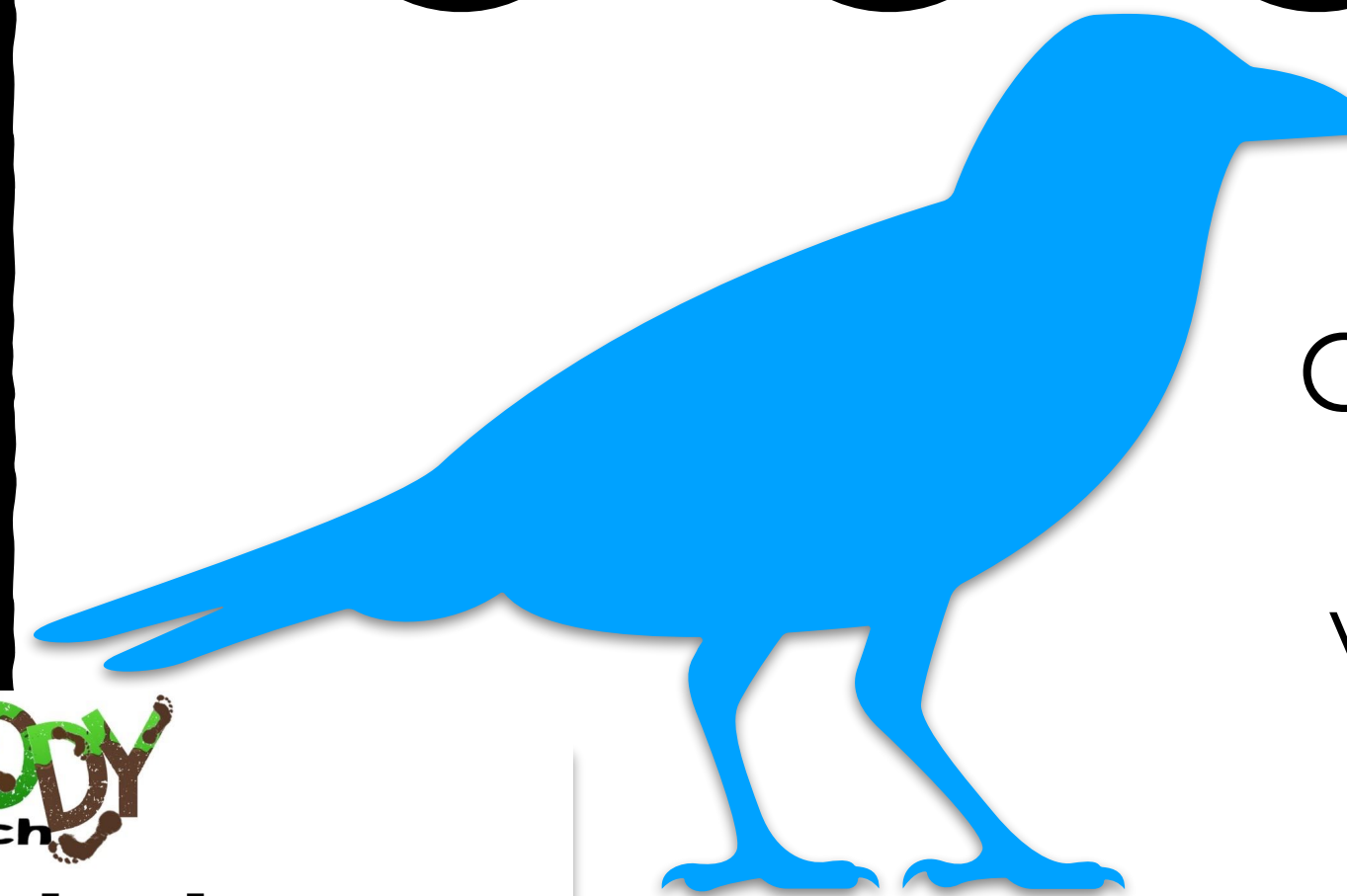

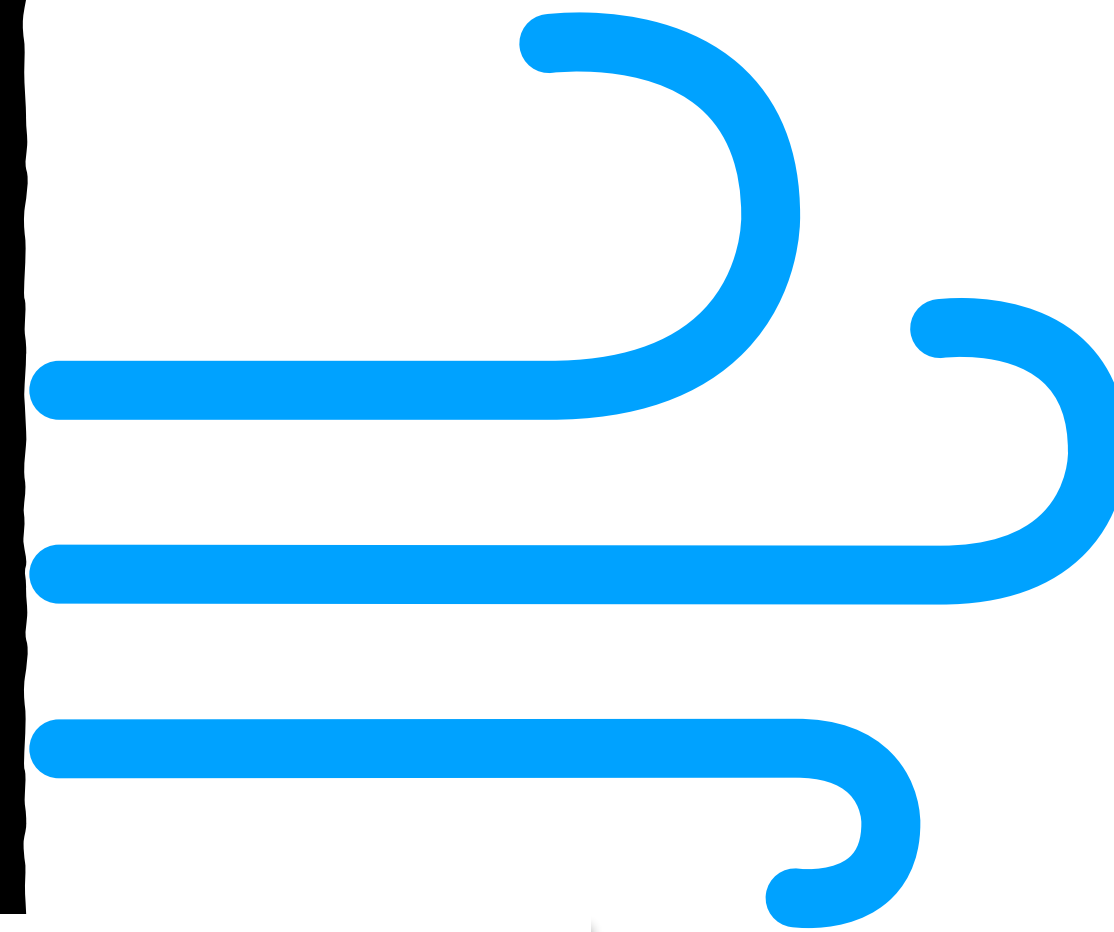


As you take a wander take time to use your senses.

Weird wander

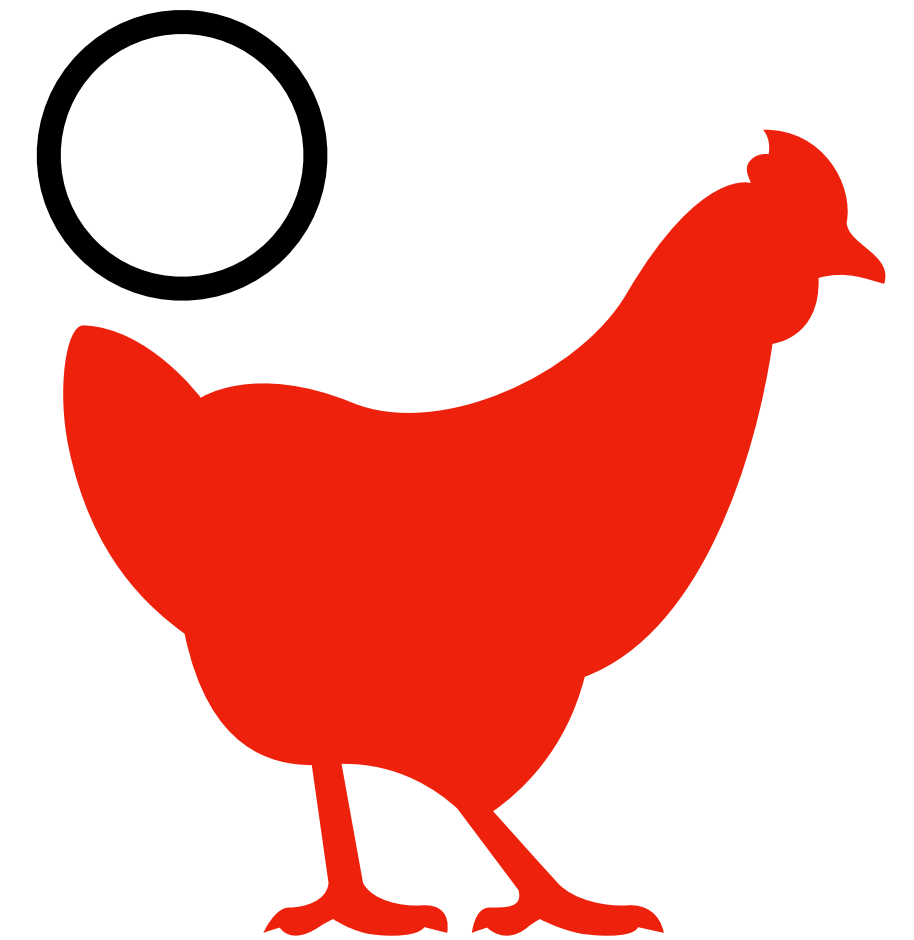
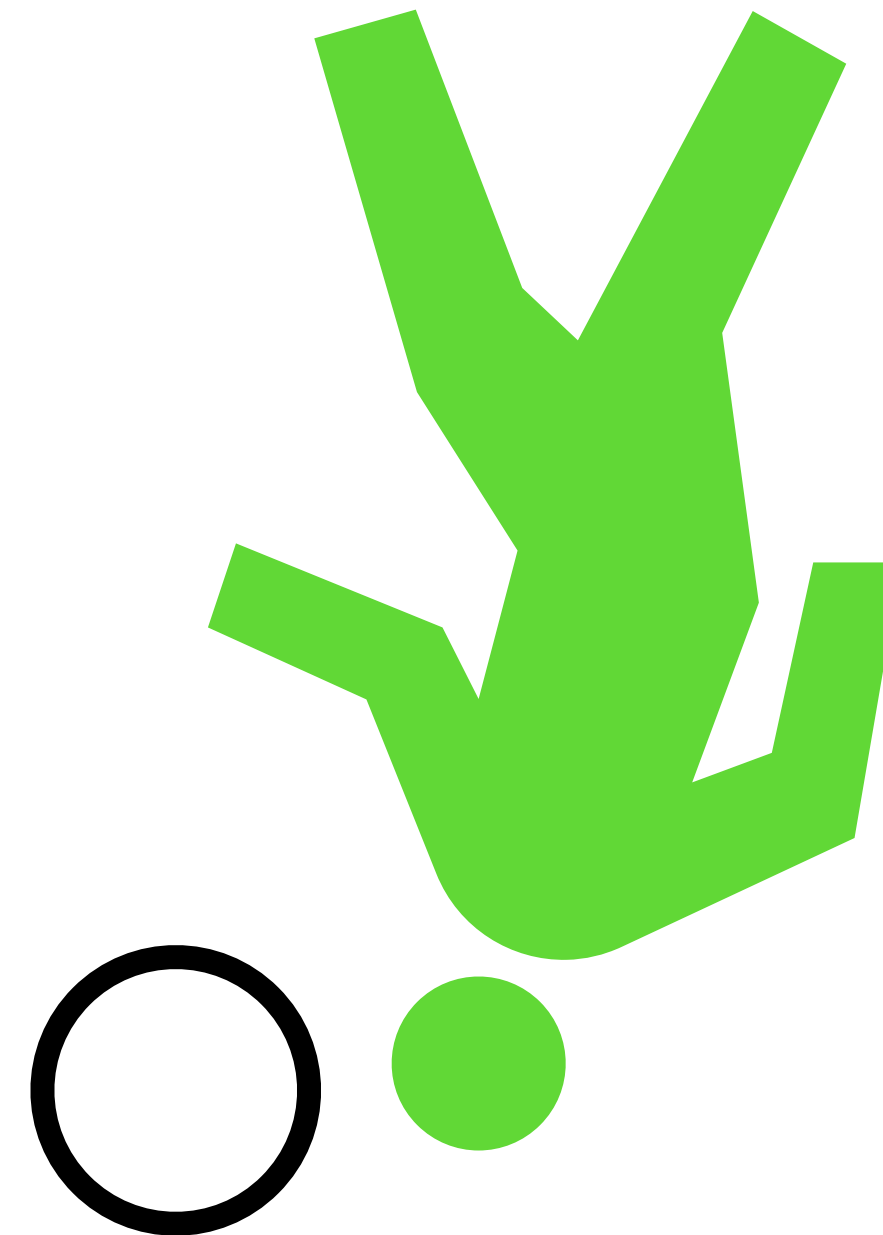
Lots of things are different right now so why not go for a weird wander.

chicken?

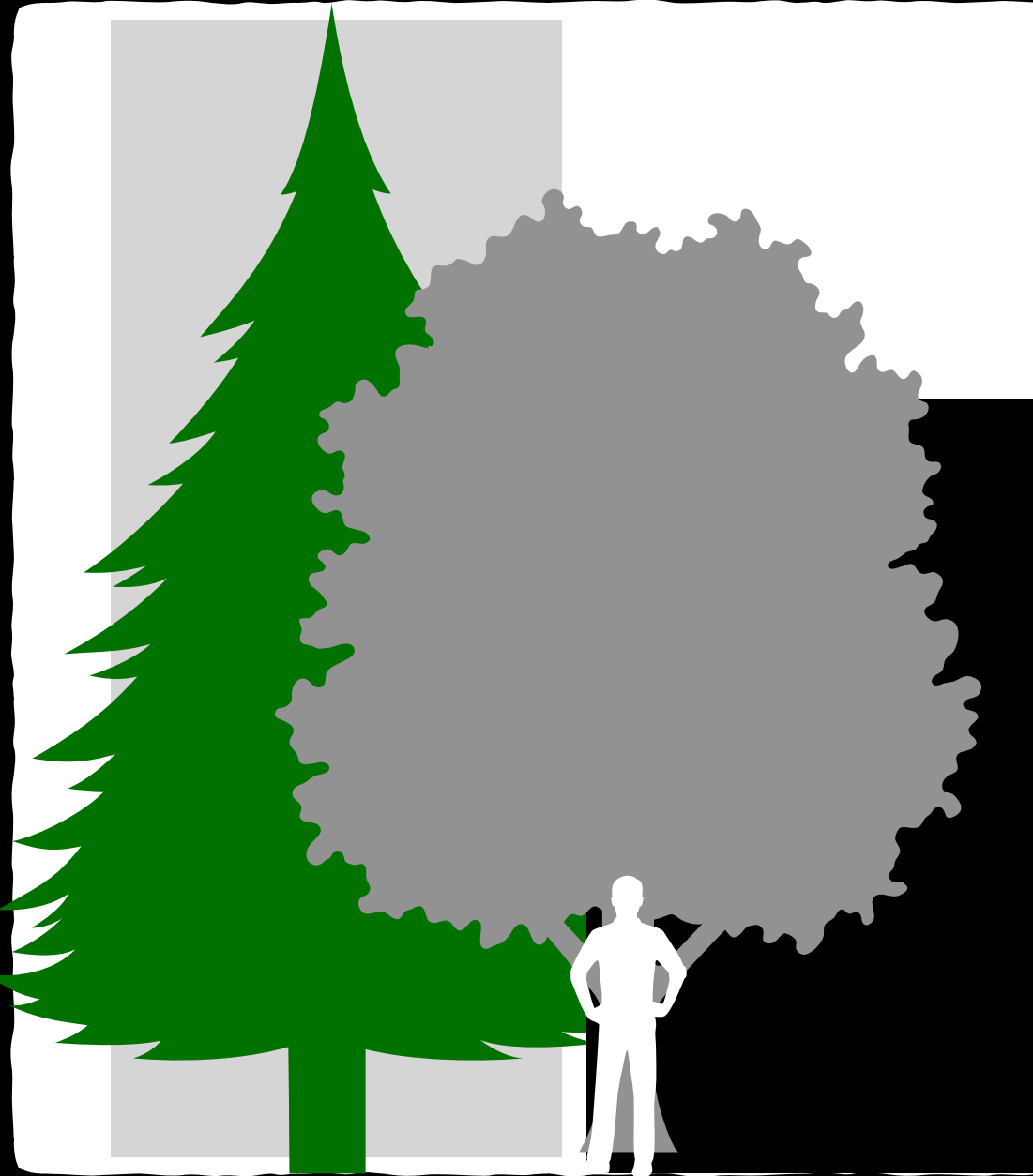

Make a growing plant.

much you are growing (or shrinking!)



You could try growing food from scraps...
Cut the top off carrots or the bottom from celery and lettuce
and place in some water and watch new growth.
