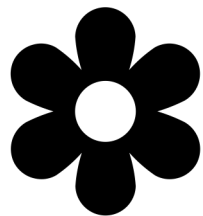

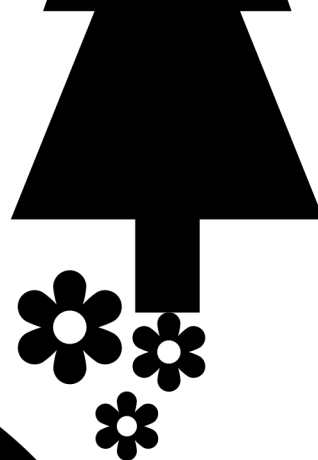


Can you see any shelters?

or nests high in trees?

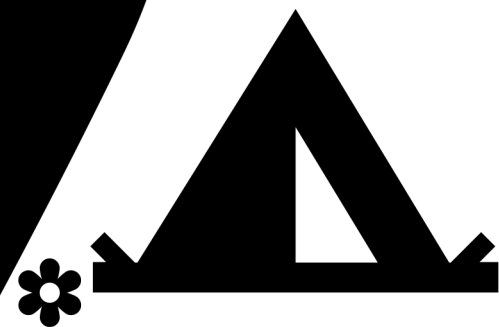

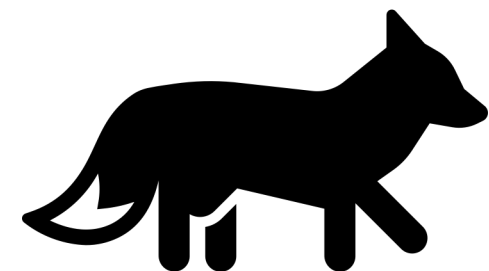
Where might God be dwelling?

What would you eat on a picnic?

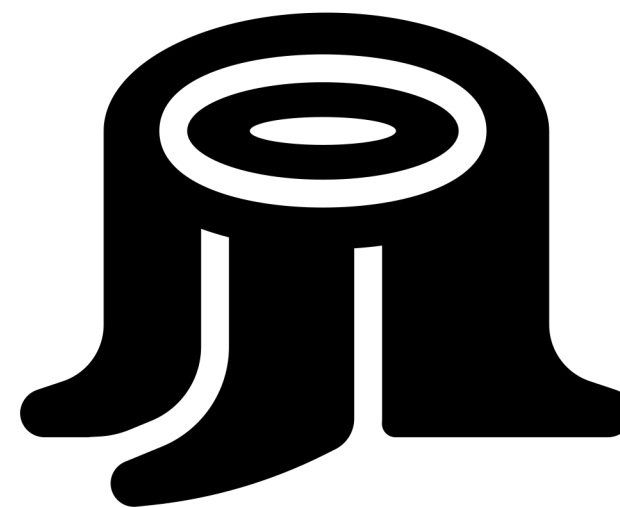

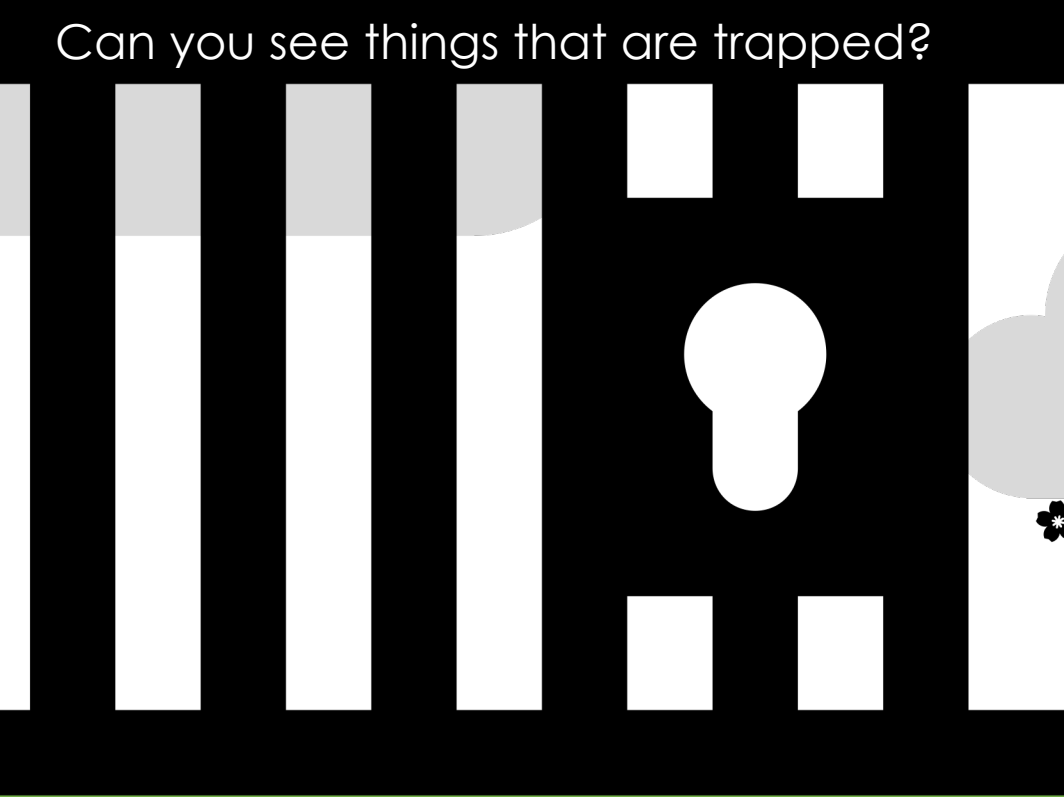




A place to sit



Can you see things that are trapped?

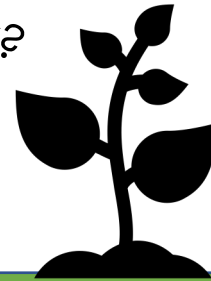


I wonder if God is ever trapped?



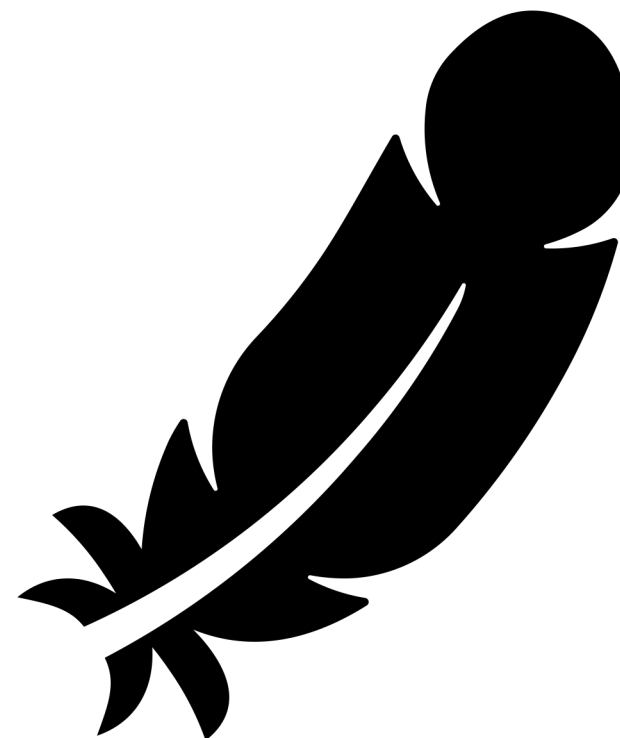
One of Jesus' friends told lies about him and Jesus was arrested. Although He had done nothing wrong a crowd of people chose for Him to die.

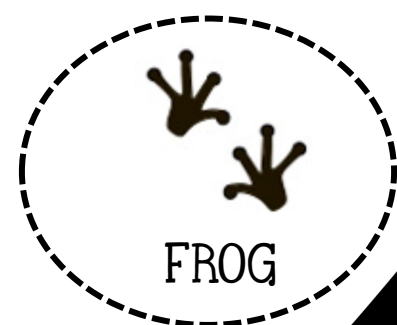

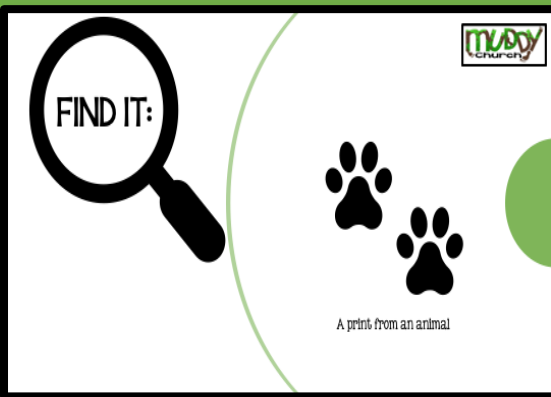

Can you see anything that has struggled?

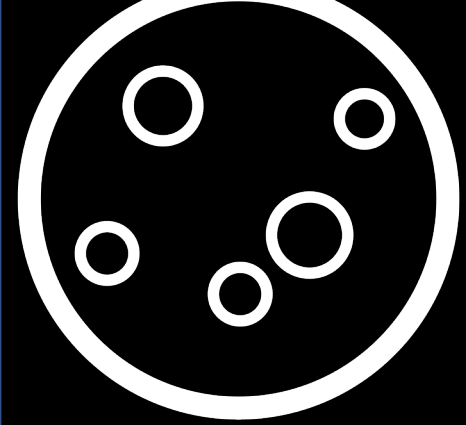

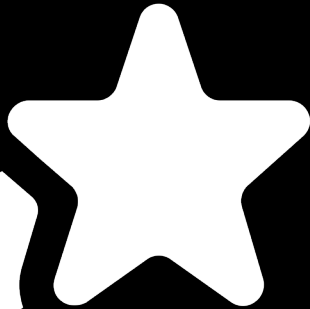

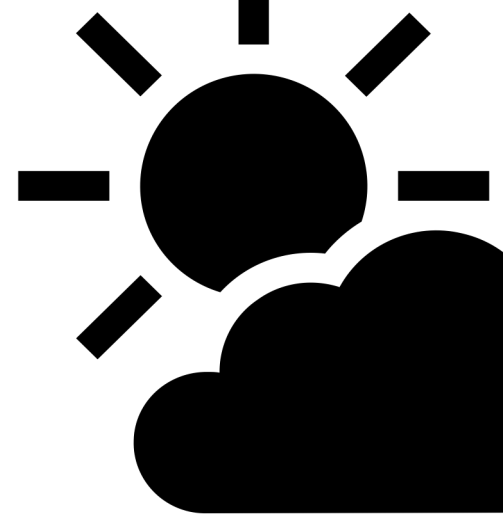
Are there any dark spaces or areas?

How do you feel in the sunlight?

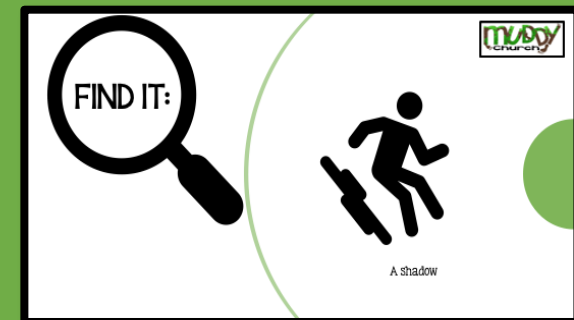
Are there spaces with lots of light?

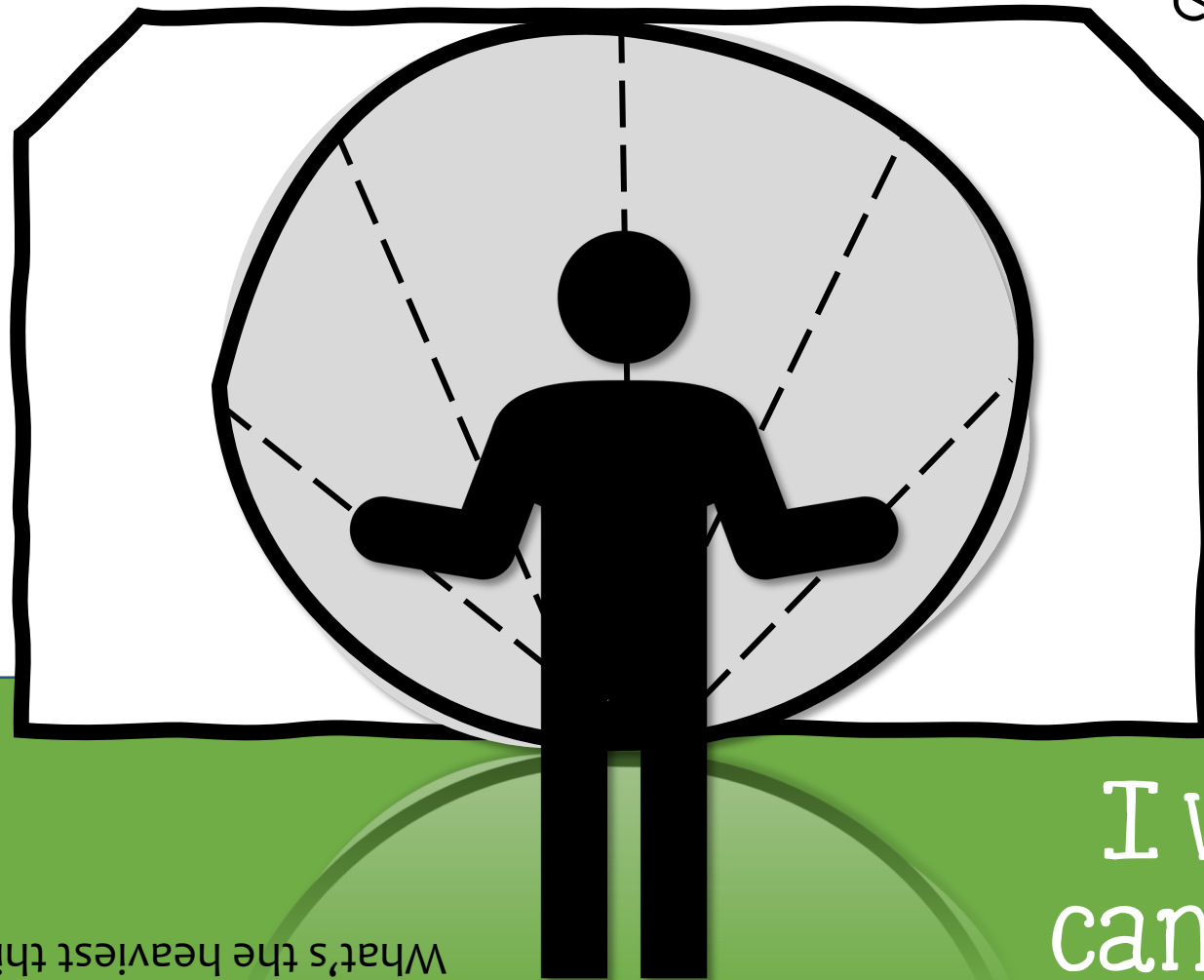
