
John 21:4-13



Early in the morning, Jesus stood on the shore, but the disciples did not realize that it was Jesus. <sup>5</sup> He called out to them, "Friends, haven't you any fish?" "No," they answered.



<sup>6</sup> He said, "Throw your net on the right side of the boat and you will find some." When they did, they were unable to haul the net in because of the large number of fish.



<sup>7</sup> Then the disciple whom Jesus loved said to Peter, "It is the Lord!" As soon as Simon Peter heard him say, "It is the Lord," he wrapped his outer garment around him (for he had taken it off) and jumped into the water.

<sup>8</sup> The other disciples followed in the boat, towing the net full of fish, for they were not far from shore, about a hundred yards.



<sup>9</sup> When they landed, they saw a fire of burning coals there with fish on it, and some bread.<sup>10</sup> Jesus said to them, "Bring some of the fish you have just caught."




<sup>11</sup> So Simon Peter climbed back into the boat and dragged the net ashore. It was full of large fish, 153, but even with so many the net was not torn.

<sup>12</sup> Jesus said to them, "Come and have breakfast." None of the disciples dared ask him, "Who are you?" They knew it was the Lord. <sup>13</sup> Jesus came, took the bread and gave it to them, and did the same with the fish.



## Counting Petals




If you can find a flower with lots of petals (like a daisy or dandelion) get people to look at the flower and guess how many petals.

Be open to asking if they noticed anything else as they were looking at the flower.

If you are near some trees you could do it to guess how many leaves.... It doesn't matter that no-one knows!

Make some flat bread to cook over a campfire (taking care!)

Flour, oil, water... mix together, make into a ball and squash it!



## Make a Nature Mandala

Find 4 large sticks or mark out a frame.

Invite people to gather items and together to make a picture or pattern within the frame.

## JUMP IN, JUMP OUT

Have an invisible line or something to represent a river (or the lake!)

On command you have to

- jump into the river (or on it)
- Jump out
- Jump over

I wonder if anything is ready for something new?








Can you spot 12 different bugs?






